NHS also serves dually diagnosed children, as long as the service need is based upon the mental health issues, and not the mental retardation. NHS employs case managers to manage each child's case, thereby ensuring intra/interagency coordination of services and continuity of care. Behavioral health services have been generally limited to children with a mental health diagnosis, for that reason, the REDCO Group-DSS division developed a specific model for behavioral health services to treat children with Autistic Spectrum Disorders and/or a DSM IV, Axis II diagnosis of mental retardation who demonstrate challenging behaviors that adversely affect the ability of the child to live at home or in the community. Recognizing that a high percentage of children with ASD also carry a diagnosis of mental retardation, the program model is specialized to treat the child and provide supports and services to the family and significant others involved in the child's life.

Valley Youth House provides P50 Service to children from birth-21. We work with all areas of disability throughout Lehigh and Northampton Counties. Each family is walked through the referral process by our P50 Coordinators and is provided with individualized services based on the family and child' strengths and needs. Valley Youth House is able to offer a continuum of services to assist the family with any level of care needed. The P50 program is supervised by a board certified behavior analyst and the program uses Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) as the framework for its programs with some focus on verbal behavior, pivotal response training, ABLLS teaching methods, and natural environment teaching. Valley Youth House also offers the Functional Family Therapy program which is an outcome-driven prevention/intervention approach to working with a wide range of problem youth and their families in various contexts. Specific phases and techniques are utilized to engage youth and families and deal with the intense negative affect that prevents change. Additional phases and techniques change family communication, interaction, problem solving and provides them with skills to better access outside system resources. Valley Youth House also offers the Family Focused Solution Based Services program which is structured to meet the needs of both the child welfare/juvenile probation systems and the mental health system through the provision of therapeutic and family support services. These services consist of a Master's level Therapist and a Bachelor's level Family Support Specialist who work to reduce the risk of violence directed toward the children, strengthen families, reduce the need for more intensive services and improve child/family integration into their community. Valley Youth House also offers the Family Based Mental Health program which consists of a team who work with emotionally troubled children and their families. The program is home based and offers a wide variety of counseling, educational and concrete services.
