**INDEPENDENT INTERNAL AUDITORS' REPORT
ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES**

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by Daniel Keen-Director of Corrections during period being audited, on administration of funds associated with commissary services and inmate telephone services. We reviewed commissary purchases made by inmates and telephone billings for inmate calls during the period from July through November 2017. The Department of Corrections' management is responsible for administration of funds associated with commissary services and inmate telephone services. The sufficiency of these procedures is solely the responsibility of the parties specified in this report. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures enumerated below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

Procedures and Findings

1. **Procedure:** Determine if inmates are being charged the correct amount for items purchased from the commissary.

Findings: Inmates are being charged the correct amount for their purchases.

2. **Procedure:** Determine if inmates are signing their order slips acknowledging receipt of what they ordered.

Findings: All receipts reviewed had inmate signatures acknowledging receipt of items.

3. **Procedure:** Determine if grievance resolution efforts by Keefe are monitored by Jail personnel.

Findings: Grievance resolution reports are not provided by Keefe to the Jail and, therefore, grievances are not monitored by the Jail personnel.

4. **Procedure:** Determine if charges for inmate telephone calls are in line with FCC rate caps.


Findings: Inmates are being charged phone rates per minute that are compliant with FCC guidelines.

We conducted this agreed-upon procedures engagement in accordance with generally accepted government auditing standards. We were not engaged to and did not conduct an examination or review, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion or conclusion, respectively, on administration of funds associated with commissary services and inmate telephone services. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion or conclusion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that would have been reported to you.
