- Grand Central Landfill/Waste Management

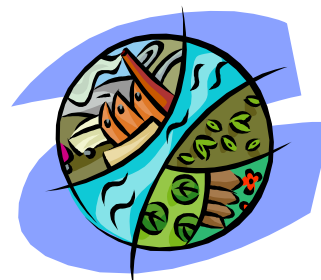
The workshop will be a combination of classroom instruction and activities as well as field work to construct Best Management Practices (BMPs) and a tour of the Welcome Center grounds which has a vast number of conservation practices already at work. The goal of the workshop is to introduce educators to BMPs they can use in their classrooms, or at their school, to hopefully encourage their students to use the practices in their households. Each educator will be provided with various resources and supplies to incorporate into their classroom conservation practices.

The workshop will provide educators with curriculum based material. The content of this workshop meets the Pennsylvania Academic Standards for Science & Technology and Environment & Ecology for grades 4 through 12, including such topics as unified themes, earth sciences, watersheds, environmental health, and humans and the environment.
