The ballot question asks the voters of Northampton County whether the County should amend the Home Rule Charter, Article IV, Controller, Section 401. Titles and Status, to remove the stipulation that the Controller could not actively engage in any other business or occupation.						
A vote of "YES" of the ballot question approves the Controller to engage in any other business or occupation, but must devote full time to the Office of Controller.
