AND NOW, this 4th day of November 2021, it is hereby

ORDERED that:

When the Attorney for the Commonwealth serving on the Northampton County Mental Health Court Team alleges that a defendant participating in the Mental Health Court Diversionary Program has committed a program violation, and the Attorney for the Commonwealth seeks the removal of the participant from the program incident thereto, the following procedures, adopted from the procedures set forth at Pa. R.

Crim. P. 318 relating to Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition, shall apply:


- (A) The attorney for the Commonwealth shall file a motion alleging that during the period of the program, the defendant has violated a condition or conditions thereof; and

- (B) The defendant shall be brought before the Court and given an opportunity to be heard with respect to the alleged violation(s) following advance written notice of the date and time of the hearing.
- (C) If the judge finds that the defendant has committed a violation or violations of a program condition, the judge may order, when the judge deems appropriate, that the defendant's participation in the program be terminated, and that the Attorney for the Commonwealth shall proceed on the charges as provided by law.
- (D) No appeal shall be allowed from such order.
- (E) This order shall take effect immediately.
