If you or a loved one needs to obtain a protection from abuse order, you can come to the Northampton County Courthouse to obtain a PFA anytime between 8:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. After 2:00 p.m., you can call 911 and a local police officer will arrange an immediate hearing before a magisterial district judge for an emergency protection from abuse order. **You Are Not Alone**—we are here for you!
