2. A "MOTION FOR PRETRIAL DISCOVERY AND INSPECTION" within FOURTEEN (14) DAYS following the date of my arraignment pursuant to Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure 305; and	

3. Various other pretrial motions available to me which must be stated

in a single document titled "OMNIBUS PRETRIAL MOTION" to be filed and served within THIRTY (30) DAYS following the date of my arraignment

pursuant to Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure 306 and 307.

My attorney and I understand that the time for the filing of the above motions is mandatory except where unusual circumstances exist or the time has been extended by the Court.

My attorney and I are aware that if I don't file the above motions in accordance with the Rules of Criminal Procedure as outlined above, I may jeopardize my right to file them at a later date.

I am hereby notified that, as a condition of bail, I am required to notify in writing, the Clerk of Courts office, the District Attorney's office, and Pre-Trial Services of any change of address and/or telephone number. This notification must be made within forty-eight (48) hours of any such change and may be made by mail or in person to each of the above offices. (Pa. Rule of Criminal Procedure 117).
