



School Community Outreach Programs

Attorneys and detectives from the Northampton County District Attorney's Office are available upon request to offer presentations to students on various legal topics.

Ages K-8

Topics for the K-8 age group may include gun safety, bullying, school threats, and internet safety. If you have a recommendation for another topic you'd like us to address to your students, please let us know.

Gun Safety: Discussion on what to do if a child comes into contact with a firearm, and on the dangers of guns in the hands of children.

Bullying: To educate children and provide them with the skills to deal with bullies without resorting to violence; help kids gain a better understanding of what bullying is and explain how to be more respectful to others.

Internet Safety: Introduce kids to the potential dangers of using the internet and discuss the importance of being aware of who they are talking to through the internet, and what information they share about themselves online.

Teens

Topics for high school students and teens may include drug abuse prevention, internet safety, sexual assault prevention, and an overview of the juvenile justice system. If you have a recommendation for another topic you'd like us to address to your students, please let us know.

Drug Abuse Prevention: Discussion on the risks of tobacco, alcohol, and other drugs and the path these avenues could take kids on, such as getting arrested and put into the juvenile justice system.

Internet Safety: Explain the potential dangers and risks of using the internet, such as those that come with certain apps and/or providing personal information online.

Sexual Assault: Discussion on who to reach out to if victimized or know someone who is a victim.

Domestic Abuse: Discussion on how to recognize abuse in the home, what to do if a child witnesses an abuse, and resources to get help in these situations. Also, how to avoid involving oneself in an abusive situation, and how to deescalate the situation before it gets to that point.
