As a condition of performing work on a project for the County of Northampton, a contractor submitting a bid shall execute this form and certify compliance with the responsible contractor qualification standards set forth below. Bids will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by a fully executed copy of this certification form. This form must be completed by an employee or other person representing the submitting firm who has the authority to execute this form and has adequate knowledge to address all matters specified herein. The person completing this form shall initial each qualification standard listed below and execute the signature requirement at the end of this form in the presence of a notary.

Contractor Qualification Standards

1. The firm has not been debarred or suspended by any federal state or local government agency or authority in the past three years. 
2. The firm has not defaulted on any project in the past three years. 
3. The firm has not had any type of business, contracting or trade license, registration, or other certification revoked or suspended in the past three years. 
4. The firm and its owners have not been convicted of any crime relating to the contracting business in the past ten years. 
5. The firm has not within the past three years been found in violation of any law applicable to its contracting business, including, but not limited to, licensing laws, tax laws, prompt payment laws, wage and hour laws, prevailing wage laws, environmental laws or others, where the result of such violation was the payment of a fine, back pay damages or any other type of penalty in the amount of \$1,000 or more. 
6. The firm meets the bonding requirements for the contract, as required by applicable law or contract specification and any insurance requirements, as required by applicable law or contract specifications, including general liability insurance, workers compensation insurance and unemployment insurance. 
7. The firm possesses all contractor licenses or certifications required by applicable federal, state or local law for the work to be performed on the project. 
8. The firm shall ensure that all craft labor personnel employed on the project shall possess any trade licenses required by applicable federal, state or local law for the work to be performed on the project. 
9. The firm shall ensure that all craft labor personal employed on the project have completed the OSHA 10-hour training course for safety established by the U.S. Department of Labor, Occupational Safety & Health Administration. 

10. The firm participates in a *Class A Apprenticeship Program for each separate trade or classification in which it employs craft employees and shall continue to participate in such program or programs for the duration of the project.

A. *For purposes of this section, a Class A Apprenticeship Program is an apprenticeship program that is currently registered with and approved by the U.S. Department of Labor or a state apprenticeship agency and has graduated apprentices to journeyperson status for at least three of the past five years.

B. To demonstrate compliance with this section, the firm shall provide, with this certification, a list of all trades or classifications of craft employees it will employ on the project and documentation verifying it participates in a Class A Apprenticeship Program for each trade or classification listed.

11. The firm has all other technical qualifications and resources, including equipment, personnel and financial resources, to perform the referenced contract, or will obtain same through the use of qualified, responsible subcontractors.

12. The firm will maintain all qualifications, resources and capabilities referenced in this certification throughout the duration of the project.

13. The firm shall notify the County of Northampton within seven days of any material changes to all matters attested to in this certification.

14. If the firm is identified as the lowest apparent bidder, it shall provide the County of Northampton, Subcontractor Responsibility Certifications executed by the identified subcontracting firms which shall contain the same information set forth in this certification.

The undersigned attests that he or she has the authority to execute this form and has sufficient knowledge to address all matters specified herein and attests, under the penalty of perjury, that the information submitted is true, complete and accurate.

In executing this Responsibility Certification, the submitting firm understands and agrees that if the County of Northampton determines that this certification contains false or misleading material information knowingly or with reckless disregard of the truth, the firm shall be prohibited from performing work for the County of Northampton for a period of three (3) years. Such circumstances shall also subject the firm to any other penalties and sanctions, including contract termination, available to the County of Northampton under law. A contract terminated under these circumstances shall further entitle the County of Northampton to withhold payment of any monies due to the firm as damages.

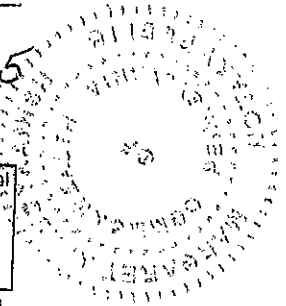

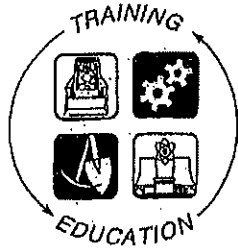
