WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the Northampton County Games, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

1. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation; and,
2. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If however, I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and
3. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assign, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS, The Northampton County Senior Games, their officers, officials, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("Releases"). WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.
4. I, the undersigned declare on my honor that I am an amateur and agree to follow the rules of the Northampton County Senior Games, tournament officials, and directors. I am in good physical condition and have no disease or injury that would impair my doing my best in competition.
5. I hereby authorize any first aid, medication, medical treatment, or surgery deemed necessary in case of an emergency. I also authorize the attending medical personnel to execute on my behalf any permission forms and other appropriate medical documents and act on my behalf if I am not immediately available to do so.
6. I hereby consent to allow my picture or likeness to appear in any official document, sponsor advertisement, and/or exclusive television coverage of the Northampton Senior Games in any manner incidental to my participation in the Northampton County Senior Games without compensation to me.
